PLANNING YOUR FRINGE EXCURSION

The Adelaide Fringe Schools Program provides assistance, benefits and resources to teachers who are booking Fringe experiences for their students. Through the program, artists offer discounted tickets for schools and free tickets for teachers - these shows are listed in this booking guide.

DEDICATED SCHOOLS PROGRAM COORDINATOR Adelaide Fringe has a dedicated Schools Program Coordinator who can assist you by: Helping you to select a show appropriate for your students Accessing discounted schools price tickets (where available) for your group Accessing free tickets for teachers (based on the D E C D teacher/student ratio) Putting you in contact with artists for in-school performances and facilitating dedicated school shows Organising and invoicing a school booking for any Fringe show (not just sessions with a schools price tickets) Issuing your tickets.

EQUITY DISCOUNT

Adelaide Fringe offers Category One to Four schools a Five Dollars Equity discount on each ticket purchased. Complimentary teacher tickets are issued according to the Department for Education teacher/student ratio: Pre-School – Year Two, One to Six : (one teacher per six students) Year Three – Year Seven, One to Ten (one teacher per ten students) Year Eight – Year Twelfth , One to Fifteen (one teacher per fifteen students) Please note this initiative is capped and we encourage Category One to Four schools to enquire with the Schools Program Coordinator as early as is convenient. Additional teachers and supervising adults above the complementary ratios are charged at the same ticket price as students.

FIRST NATIONS CULTURAL TOURS

Sunday Sixteen February

Forty-five min duration

Tours run every twenty min from Three P M to Seven P M

Learn about the spiritual and cultural connection to Country of First Nations people on an enriching and intimate Aboriginal cultural tour of Adelaide Botanic Garden. Gather at The Mulberry Arbor to meet your guide before exploring native plants, bush tucker and the social history of Australia's First Peoples. Experience a traditional smoking ceremony led by respected Elders and cultural leaders after the tour.

Selected tours will be accessible with the following services: Auslan Interpretation, Audio Description, tactile guided tour, and paved-surfaces only. The tours are forty-five minutes and are free, registration is required. Book now to avoid disappointment.
