ACCESSIBILITY ICONS

VENUE ACCESSIBILITY

Step-free Mobility-Aid Access (Image Description: Black and white picture of a person in a wheelchair) Step-free access through main entrance. Venues with a step-free mobility-aid accessible icon have an accessible bathroom. If there is no icon, the space may not have an accessible bathroom or may not be accessible for another reason.

Alternate Access (Image Description: Black and white person in a wheelchair entering a door):

Step-free access through an alternate entry point.

Stair Access Only (Image Description: Grey triangle with picture of stairs going up)
This venue only has entry via stairs.

BOOKING AN ACCESSIBLE TICKET

You can book tickets online at adelaidefringe.com.au/fringetix and advise of any accessibility requirements at checkout, which will be passed on to the venue.

You can book tickets over the phone by calling the priority accessibility booking line on Zero Eight Eight One Zero Zero Two Zero Eight Nine. If required, you can contact Adelaide Fringe through the National Relay Service on One Three Three Six Seven Seven.

You can book tickets in-person at Fringe Corner, which features an accessible lowered counter, hearing loop and visual communication boards. Volunteers and Box Office staff are trained to support your accessibility needs.

Companion Card tickets are available to all shows. Book a Companion Card ticket alongside a paid ticket through the website (after an initial online verification process), at the box office, or via the accessibility booking line on Zero Eight Eight One Zero Zero Two Zero Eight Nine.

SACARE CARERS LOUNGE Located at Grenfell Street outside Tandanya. The SACARE Carers Lounge is a dedicated disability and sensory-friendly space designed to support people of all ages with changing, feeding, and sensory needs. The area will feature a low sensory zone and changing place with height adjustable change table and lifter. Free to all and open daily during the festival, please check our accessibility website page for opening times. The Carer's Lounge will be closed on days where temperatures exceed Forty degrees Celsius.

HEALTH PARTNERS SENSORY BACKPACKS Pick up a Sensory Backpack from the Fringe Box Office at the corner of Rundle Rd and East Tce to help make your Fringe adventure more comfortable and accessible. Proudly supported by our Major Partner, Health Partners. If you're able, a donation to the Adelaide Fringe Foundation is always appreciated.

HIDDEN DISABILITIES SUNFLOWER The Hidden Disabilities Sunflower is a globally recognised symbol for non-visible disabilities. All Adelaide Fringe staff and volunteers have completed training to understand how to support people who wear the Sunflower.

GUIDE DOGS and ASSISTANCE ANIMALS Guide dogs and assistance animals are welcome at all venues that are open to the public.

ACCESSIBILITY PARTNER PROFILES

Access Two Arts works to amplify the voices of d/Deaf and disabled people in the arts and celebrate their unique perspectives, stories and aesthetics. We support d/Deaf and disabled South Australians to get involved in the arts as audiences and artists; and help Arts and Cultural organisations to become more inclusive and accessible.

Autism SA is South Australia's autism peak body and the oldest organisation of its kind in Australia. For over Sixty years, we've championed inclusion and participation for autistic people and their families, providing trusted information, advocacy and sector leadership to help build a more accessible and inclusive South Australia.

For more than Sixty-Five years, Guide Dogs SA/NT has used our expertise in dogs and vision to promote independence, participation, inclusion, and well-being for people with low vision, blindness, or specialised needs. At Guide Dogs SA/NT, we deliver specialised support across therapies, assistive technology, Human Guide Training, and Guide, Assistance and Facility Dogs. Recognising that no two journeys are the same, we provide flexible, personalised services that respond to each person's needs. We also partner with businesses to support and strengthen their disability and inclusion action plans, helping to build more accessible and welcoming spaces for everyone. As one of Australia's most trusted charities, we are committed to making our community more accessible and inclusive through hands-on support, advocacy, and education.

Escape the Fringe buzz at SACARE's Carers Lounge - A calm, supportive space designed for people living with disability and their carers. Unwind in our sensory zone, complete with interactive screens, bubble tubes, and a magic carpet. The lounge also features a fully equipped kitchen and comfortable seating area for food preparation, medication needs, and quiet breaks. For added support, the space includes an adult sized change room with a height-adjustable change table and hoist. The SACARE Carers Lounge is free to access and open daily throughout the festival. Please visit our accessibility page for opening hours. Note: the lounge will close on days when temperatures exceed Forty degrees Celsius for the safety of all visitors.
