

YOUR VISIT - *Sea Wall* at Space Theatre

Due to COVID-19, things will be a little different during your upcoming visit to Space Theatre. Please read this email carefully and visit the [FAQ page](#) on our website before your visit.

Your arrival: Please plan to arrive 10-15 minutes before the performance. Put on a face mask and check-in using a QR code. Once inside, please take your seats in the auditorium.

Venue doors will open 30 minutes before the performance and there will be a queue outside, so dress appropriately. **The performance will begin on time.**

How do I check-in? Check-in using the QR codes outside the theatre. If you need to sign-in using a pen and paper, you may do so inside.

Do I need to wear a mask? All patrons aged 12 and over must wear a face mask inside the building, including during the performance. If you do not have a mask to wear, staff will provide one. Patrons are not required to wear masks if they have a relevant medical condition. Thank you for your cooperation.

Where are your seats? Theatre seating is general admission. You may be seated immediately next to another patron and you will have patrons sitting in the rows in front and behind you. Please follow the instructions of theatre attendants.

What should you bring? Hand sanitiser will be available onsite but to avoid queues and congestion, we recommend you bring your own as well. Water fountains are closed so make sure you bring a bottle of water, too.

What not to bring? To avoid close contact and touching, cloakings are available for emergencies only. Please do not bring bags larger than A3 or backpacks as they will not be admitted into the auditorium.

Are the bars open? Foyer bars and water fountains are closed.

COVID Safe behaviour:

- Do not come to the theatre if you have cold or flu symptoms.
- Wash your hands often. Cover coughs and sneezes in your arm.
- Keep 1.5m from others wherever possible in foyers and queues.
- Wear a face mask at all times inside the building.
- Use the COVIDSafe check-in QR Code when you arrive.

Drop off and pedestrian access: For vehicle drop off, use King William Road, the Intercontinental Hotel, or the accessible drop off behind the Convention Centre (enter from Montefiore Road). From North Terrace, walk behind the Intercontinental Hotel and down the stairs or lift to the Dunstan Playhouse.

We recommend strongly that you plan your visit carefully. We look forward to seeing you and hope you enjoy the show!
