

## Character descriptions



If you receive this character you are a Villager. No special powers but an important role when the voting as to who gets hanged in the daily executions.



If you receive this character you are Cupid. Cupid has the power to make two people fall in love. Cupid will pick two lovers. The lovers must protect each other, they can not vote for or kill one another as if one of them dies the other dies of heart-break.



If you receive this character you are the Hunter. Unfortunately for the Hunter this character only comes into play as you are about to die. You have either been mauled by the Werewolves or on the gallows about to be strung up by your fellow villagers. But you get one last dieing shot, hopefully to take out a Werewolf and not a fellow villager.



If you receive this character you are the Witch. The Witch has two very powerful potions. There is one to heal and one to kill, but be very careful how and when you use these potions as there is only one of each to last the whole game. The Witch can elect to save the healing potion for themselves although this may be a little selfish if the village is being decimated by the Werewolves. Be very careful how and when you use the killing potion as ideally you want to be taking out a Werewolf and not a villager.



If you receive this character you are the Seer. This is possibly the most powerful charcter for the village. At the beginning of every round the Seer will get to see the identity of another member of the village. So the Seer will be looking for the Werewolves and the Werewolves will be after the Seer.



If you receive this character you are not a villager, you are a Werewolf. As night falls you will awake and with your fellow Werewolves take out one innocent sleeping villager.
