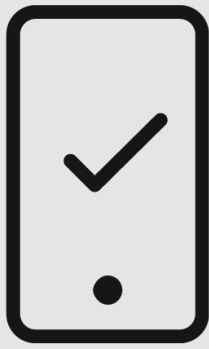

COVID CHECK-IN

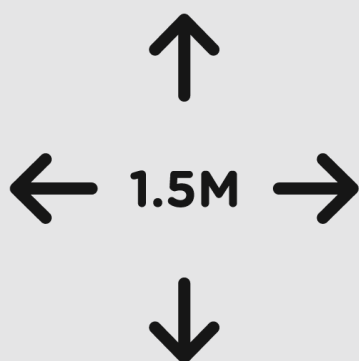

To avoid foyer congestion, the auditorium will open approximately 75 minutes before start time. Entry to the auditorium will be staggered. No door tickets will be available.

CHECKERBOARD SEATING

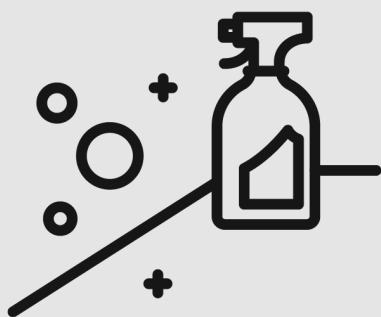
Checkerboard seating will be used to accommodate adequate spacing in each row, with consideration given to patrons in the rows in front and behind you. We ask that you sit in same seat for the duration of the performance and, even though you can still be close to your family and friends, you will not be permitted to sit in the seat immediately next to another patron.

GETTING TO THE THEATRE

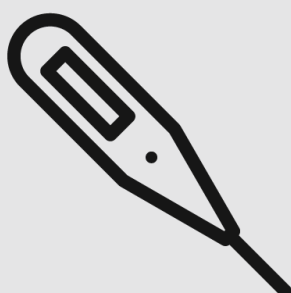
